ANCC Student Poster Guidelines

In light of the poster session being moved to an online format, the traditional single page print poster format has been replaced by an electronic poster.

The content of an online poster mimics traditional print posters, yet offers the potential to enhance readability through provision of increased space to present the background, objectives, materials and methods, results, conclusions, references and acknowledgements.

Please note: Only content directly related to the abstract may be included.

Poster guidelines:

- Length: Posters may be 1 3 pages (max).
- <u>File type:</u> Posters may be created using any preferred software, however must be submitted in PDF format.
- Orientation: Landscape (Standard Letter Dimensions)
- <u>Content</u>: Each slide/page of the poster must contain the abstract number, title, and authors. Student authors may include a headshot if desired.
- <u>Font</u>: To facilitate ease of reading, a minimum font size of 11 is required throughout on all text, tables and figures.
- Excessive text or crowding of information should be avoided.
- Avoid use of embedded hyperlinks. These will not be enabled.
