

Dr. Joel Caton, North Dakota State University



Dr. Joel Caton attended New Mexico State University for his BS, University of Missouri for his MS, and New Mexico State University for his Ph.D. After a postdoctoral fellowship at the University of Missouri, he accepted a research and teaching position at North Dakota State University where he has continued to work in ruminant nutrition, metabolism, and digestive physiology. Dr. Caton teaches both undergraduate and graduate students and has advised or co-advised 42 graduate student degree programs thus far in his career. He has published extensively in scientific journals and conference proceedings, and has given numerous invited presentations at national and international venues. Dr. Caton recently served on the NRC committee to update the Nutrient Requirements of Beef Cattle, 8th Revised Edition and as the Associate Editor-in-Chief for the Journal of Animal Science. He also currently serves on the American Society of Animal Science Board of Directors and on the National Animal Nutrition Program (NRSP-9). Dr. Caton has received awards from North Dakota State University and The American Society of Animal Science for his research accomplishments.
